



Westbury Junior School Sports Premium Activity Report 2016/17

Sports Clubs

6 extra-curricular sports clubs were provided free of charge to children:

- Tag Rugby
- Boys' Football
- Girls' Football
- Gymnastics
- Tennis
- Rounders & Cricket

75 children attended extra-curricular sports clubs over the year.

Internal Competitions

Ten Year 6 pupils organised and officiated a whole week of intra-school football tournaments, in which all year groups competed within their own year group. In total, 83 pupils participated in the football tournaments.

Wiltshire Cricket organised an internal tournament between all Year 3 pupils as the culmination of their sequence of coaching sessions. In total, 54 pupils participated in the cricket tournament.

School Sports Day – the highlight of our sporting year – saw all year groups and abilities participating and competing against each other in a wide variety of athletics activities, competitions and races. In total, over 200 pupils participated in Sports Day.

External Competitions

Teams representing Westbury Junior School attended four competitive sports fixtures and one participation fixture, including two SEND events:

- Westbury RFC Tag Rugby Festival (16 pupils)
- Kurling and Boccia at Warminster (10 pupils)
- Westbury Swimming Gala (23 pupils)
- Athletics day at Matravers (52 pupils)
- Fairfield Farm College Colour Run (10 pupils)

In total 111 pupils participated in external sports fixtures.

Staff Training

Members of school staff attended 5 CPD courses: Cricket, Inclusive Coaching, Inclusive Tennis, Dance, Orienteering.
